## TUITION + FEES

Tuition for the RN to BSN completion track is \$395 per credit hour. (Effective August 2017 to June 2018). Tuition includes course-related fees, such as testing, student services and course resource fees. Expenses for books and supplies are the responsibility of the student.

## FINANCIAL AID

You may be eligible for additional financial aid, such as the South Carolina Tuition Grant or the Federal Pell Grant. **Live or work in Newberry County?** You may be eligible for the **Newberry Community Scholarship**. Ask your admission counselor for details.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Because the RN to BSN completion track is designed for working professionals, the following requirements must be met by students admitted to this program:

- Active licensure as a Registered Nurse
- Current employment in a nursing role (full- or part-time)
- Graduate of an accredited ADN program
- Grade of "C" or better on all prerequisite courses:
  - Human Anatomy & Physiology (2 semesters)
  - Freshman English or equivalent (2 semesters)
  - Microbiology
  - Public Speaking
  - Statistics (prerequisite to NUR 471)
